What Would Cosmo Do?







Cosmo knows the roles of lockout/tagout Responsibilities:

Risk Management and Safety (RMS)

- The RMS Department will review this program annually
- Will help supervisors interpret government regulations
- Will provide general LOTO training as requested and perform spot checks
 <u>Supervisors</u>
- Ensure that Authorized Individuals are performing work within the scope of this program and receive necessary training
- Will carry out all disciplinary actions for those who fail to us requirements

Departments

- Departments should review LOTO program annually
- Designate Authorized Individuals using Appendix D, and provide a copy to RMS
- Shall verify Authorized Individuals are completing LOTO procedure checklist forms and procedures

Authorized Individuals

- Before performing maintenance or servicing equipment, will complete an assessment (Appendix A or similar)
- Shall verify that isolation and de-energization of the machine or equipment has been accomplished

Affected Individuals

- Shall be knowledgeable with the contents of this program
- Shall not take part in LOTO procedures

Up to 10% of individual safety incidents are believed to be related to failure to properly lock out equipment
