Cosmo knows his employee rights **Which BYU Employees Have Access?**



- A current or former employee may have been exposed to toxic substances or harmful physical agents.
- An employee who was assigned to work involving toxic substances or harmful physical agents.
- The legal representative of a deceased or legally incapacitated employee who may have been exposed to toxic substances or harmful physical agents.

Accessible in 3 Ways:

1 BYU may give employees a copy of the document

2 BYU may loan employees the document to copy it offsite

3 BYU may provide facilities for employees to copy the document

Available Records Include:



- Monitoring results of workplace air or measurements of toxic substances or harmful physical agents
- Biological monitoring results
- Safety data sheets (SDS)
- Medical and employment questionnaires or histories
- Results of medical examinations and laboratory tests
- Medical opinions, diagnoses, progress notes, and recommendations
