When to Re-Train:

Operator uses machine unsafely Operator has been in an accident or near-miss

Operator is unfamiliar with equipment Conditions in workplace change

General Definitions:



Fail Safe: Ensures that if any abnormal condition happens, the equipment will immediately default to a state of suspended operation without any hazard.

Machine guards: Prevent physical contact with the equipment's moving parts and mechanical hazards
