# Cosmo knows each responsibility Biological Safety Officer





- Trains students on safety
- Helps the PI create the biosafety manual
- Inspects the lab and does risk assessments
- Serves on the IBC

## **Principal Investigator**

### What does the PI do?

- Notifies ORCA of work with covered agents before starting
- Prepares the biosafety manual and trains people in the lab!
- Sets restrictions and qualifications for who can work in the lab
- Maintains any training records

## **IBC and ORCA**

#### What is the IBC?

- IBC stands for Institutional Biosafety Committee
- The IBC reviews and approves work with covered agents
- The IBC also reviews facility inspections

### What Is ORCA?

- ORCA stands for Office of Research and Creative Activities
- ORCA provides an administrator for the IBC
- ORCA notifies the BSO and IBC of applications for covered material use

Biological agents include bacteria, viruses, fungi, other microorganisms and their toxins
