# Cosmo drives responsibly Who Does this Affect?

#### All BYU personnel including faculty, staff, and students who:

- Drive a truck or truck and trailer that weighs over 10,001 pounds
- Drive a truck that transports placarded amounts of hazardous waste
- Drive a van that transports more than 15 passengers
- Drive a van that transports more than 8 people for compensation



"A" Class:

Required to operate vehicles with a gross combination weight over 26,000 pounds, provided the combined weight of the vehicle towed is more than 10,000 pounds

#### **CDL Requirements**

"B" Class:

pounds

Required to operate single vehicles having a gross combined weight of 26,000 pounds or vehicle towing under 10,000

"C" Class"
Required to operate any size vehicle (less than 26,001 pounds) that carries hazardous materials and requires placards, or carries more than 15 passengers

### **CMV Requirements**



A Commercial Motor Vehicle is a vehicle that has a gross vehicle weight of 10,001 pounds or more. The gross combination weight can be a vehicle pulling a trailer. A class D driver's license is required unless the vehicle weight limits reach the CDL requirement.
