Cosmo meets all driving requirements Random Drug and Alcohol Screening

- All CMV Drivers are entered into a random drug and alcohol screening and a percentage will be selected each quarter
- All Non-CDL drivers will be entered into a separate testing database and 10 individuals each quarter are randomly selected
 IF SELECTED:
- The driver must report to an Intermountain Health Care WorkMed clinic within two hours of being notified.

DOT Medical Card

- Prior to driving, all CMV drivers must complete a DOT medical physical. Upon passing, the driver will obtain a DOT medical card
- The DOT Medical Card expires two years from the date of issue
- Drivers may not drive until RMS receives results from the medical physical
- All physicals and relates testing must be completed at Intermountain Health Care WorkMed clinic

CMV Practical Exam and Certification Card

- Before being awarded a BYU non-CDL Truck Driving Training Card, the practical examination must be completed
- The practical is conducted by a Competent Person designated by RMS and shall not last longer than 30 minutes
