COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE: LOGGING DEVICES What Would Cosmo Do?



Cosmo uses an ELD when required Electronic Logging Devices (ELD)



- All drivers required to prepare hours-of-service records of duty status (RODS) and who operate commercial motor vehicles involved in interstate commerce must have a vehicle equipped with an ELD, that is:
- Certified and registered un the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) registered ELD list.

Driver ELD Requirements:

A driver using an ELD must have the following:

- A user's manual describing how to operate the ELD
- An instruction sheet describing the data transfer mechanisms
- An instruction sheet describing ELD malfunction reporting requirements during malfunctions
- A supply of blank RODS sufficient to record the duty status for a minimum of eight days

Exception to ELD Regulations



- Driver's are exempt if they meet one or more of the following:
- Short-haul operations in 100 air-mile radius
- Operation of the CMV for short-haul operations in 150 air-mile radius
- Operation of no more than eight days out of any 30 consecutive day period
