Cosmo always checks before entering a confined space!

When entering a confined space, ask yourself these questions!

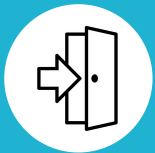
- Moving parts?
- Electrical hazards?
- Hydraulic or pneumatic hazards?
- Solid or liquid engulfment hazards?
- Constriction hazard?
- Any other serious hazards?
- Hazardous atmosphere?

***If yes to any of these questions, use a Full Permit System for entry!**

Full Permit System

- Don't enter a hazardous space unless an authorized attendant is present at all times!
- If there is no hazard during entry, no supervisor or attendant is required!
- Follow the Hot Work Permit program if there is use of welding, cutting, brazing, or any other flame/spark producing operation

Communication



**Always maintain communication
between you and the attendant!**

**Deaths often occur in confined space because the atmosphere is oxygen-deficient,
toxic or combustible**
