Cosmo only enters confined spaces if it is controlled!

Air Monitoring



- Always make sure to use an explosion proof calibrated confined space meter before and during entry!
- Record readings on the Confined Space Entry Form
- Only conduct air monitoring if you are trained to do so!
- Immediately exit the confined space if the meter alarm sounds

Atmospheric Hazards

- Use forced air ventilation to control atmospheric hazards!
- Do not enter a workspace that doesn't have a controlled atmosphere
- If gas welding or cutting, keep gas cylinders and welding machines outside the space

Always maintain communication between you and the attendant!

Ventilation hoses provide air and exhaust toxic vapors during confined space entry
